The 2022-2028 Medium-Term Fiscal Framework (MTFF)

- 6.5 7.5% real gross domestic product (GDP) growth in 2022
 6.5-8% real GDP growth annually between 2023 to 2028
- 9% (i.e., single-digit) poverty rate by 2028
- 3% national government (NG) deficit to GDP ratio by 2028
- Less than 60% NG debt-to-GDP ratio by 2025
- At least \$4,256 income (GNI) per capita (attainment of upper middle-income status)


Digital Transformation of the Bureaucracy




Government Integrated Financial Management Information System (GIFMIS)
